Since 1976, Kelli Ann has been an active equestrian competitor, riding and training all her horses from breaking them to Grand Prix level. Kelli trained with Carol Lavell (1996 Olympian aboard Gifted) from 1980 – 1985. In 1985 Kelli began training with Michael Poulin.

Kelli's first accomplishment was with "Special Bid", a 3 year old she imported in 1984, and trained exclusively on her own. Her accomplishments were recognized in 1985 when they won their first USDF Horse of the Year Championship with a score median score of 72%. Kelli and Special Bid continued their success to the Grand Prix level earning awards at every level for AHSA, USDF and NEDA with a high score of 82% at the New England Sweepstakes and AHSA National Championships. Kelli and Special Bid were on the USET Top Fifteen list at the FEI levels.

Kelli also successfully broke, trained and competed Christmas Spirit to the Intermediate 1 level earning numerous awards and scores in the mid 70s%. This pair was so popular they have been featured at the Equine Affaire Pfizer Fantasia show performing a breathtaking musical freestyle.

With Kelli's extensive knowledge and years of training horses, from placing a saddle on their backs, the first time to competing them to Grand Prix, she prides herself on working with both horse and rider as a harmonious team. In 1999 Kelli studied with Kenny Harlow, a John Lyons certified trainer, using Kenny's own program "Training with Trust" to incorporate round penning and problem solving of issues as a new safer way to break young horses and prepare them for their owners.

Kelli has competed a variety of other horses for her clients and other professionals, successfully obtaining numerous USEF, USDF and NEDA awards and championships. Today Kelli is bringing along a variety of horses she has bred and trained at her Jest-A-Bit farm in Pepperell, MA. Kelli will compete her horses Jest-A-Jesture, Majestic Art, Jest-A-Surprise showing at USEF and Prix St George levels in 2009. We look forward to seeing them in dressage arena.
